1. Prerequisite for LAW 880 Clinical Legal Education; LAW 710 Pre-Trial Practice; LAW 736 Judicial Administration Seminar; LAW 760 Trial Tactics & Strategy; LAW 890 Trial Advocacy; LAW 892 Civil Trial Workshop; LAW 893 Criminal Trial Workshop; LAW 899 Medical Malpractice Workshop; LAW 894 Trial Simulation.

2. Strongly suggested as a prerequisite for LAW 730 Corporations.
3. Will be offered in the Spring 1983 semester also. Prerequisite for LAW 725 Estate Planning and LAW 770 Taxation of Business Organizations. Strongly recommended as a prerequisite to LAW 715 Estate and Gift Taxes.
4. Prerequisite for LAW 880 Clinical Legal Education (Criminal); LAW 893 Criminal Trial Workshop; LAW 890 Trial Advocacy.
5. Enrollment limited to twenty (20) students.
6. Prerequisites: LAW 614 Evidence and LAW 645 Criminal Procedure. Students enrolling in this course may not enroll in LAW 736 Judicial Administration Seminar and LAW 890 Trial Advocacy. You must have completed two years of law school by the beginning of the Fall 1982 semester to enroll in the course. You must have permission of the professor to enroll.
7. Prerequisites: You must have a cumulative grade point average of 2.0 or better and have completed three semesters of law school. Any student enrolling in this course for the Fall 1982 semester must also enroll in the course for the Spring 1983 semester unless he/she took the course during the summer term 1982. This course will be graded on a pass/fail basis. You must have permission of the professor to enroll.
8. Strongly recommended as a prerequisite Constitutional Law I and II. Enrollment limited to twenty (20) students.
9. Open only to students who will graduate at the end of the Fall 1982 semester. All students intending to graduate at the end of this term must enroll for Professional Responsibility, unless he/she took the course during the summer term 1982.
10. Prerequisites: LAW 730 Corporations and LAW 700 Federal Income Tax
11. Prerequisite for Estate Planning. Strongly recommended prerequisite LAW 700 Federal Income Tax.
12. Any student wishing to enroll in this course must have a signed course approval form from the Professor who will supervise the student. Any student enrolling in this course must have a cumulative grade point average of 2.0 or better.
13. All currently enrolled first year students must enroll in Constitutional Law I.
14. Prerequisites: Federal Income Tax; Wills and Trusts.
