DATE: October 7, 1985

In accordance with our published policy on registration, the Doctoral Students in the international programs must register for two courses in each term. For the sake of efficiency we are no longer able to register students for one course at a time. As with other institutions of higher education we are charging tuition on a term-by-term basis. Our trimester tuition fee is \$2,000 which entitles the student up to two courses per trimester. The accounting office may facilitate payments of fees to the extent that it would make it possible for the student to make payments on an agreed basis.

Our Trimesters are:	<u>Registration Deadlines</u>
August 1- November 30	July 15th
December 1- March 31	November 15
April 1-July 31	March 15

All the students for the Winter Term must register for two courses by November 15th. Otherwise a late registration fee of \$25 will be assessed. Those who do not register for the next term- other than the international students and students on loan who are required to carry a full time load, will be assessed \$100 for continuation fees.

Enclosed, please find a registration form, and course schedule for this purpose. Please note that we are now offering a directed special topics course in each term which will enable you to maintain full time status, improve your GPA, and reinforce your studies. The special topics are as follows:

1. DBA-IM 6180 Special Topics in International Management;
2. DBA-IM 6380 Special Topics in International Finance;
3. DBA-IM 6685 Special Topics in Comparative Government & Economic Systems;
4. DBA-IM 6780 Special Topics in Economic Policy and Development;
5. DBA-IM 6880 Special Topics in International Business;
6. DBA-IM 6980 Special Topics in International Marketing;

Only one of the above courses may be substituted for the corresponding course in the curriculum. Students may take additional courses to improve their GPA, competency to pass the comprehensive exam, or to maintain full-time status.
