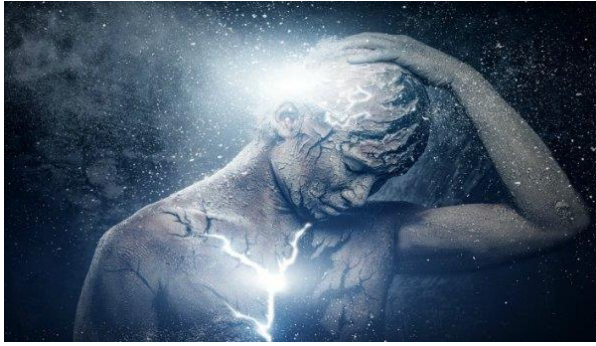


CALL FOR SUBMISSIONS
