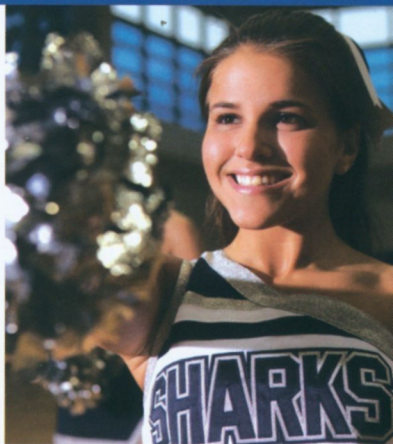



Graduate School of Computer and Information Sciences






Oceanographic Center

Oceanographic Center (OC) graduate students gain classroom, laboratory, and field knowledge to become the next generation of marine researchers, managers, and conservationists. Our faculty members' fields include coral reef ecology and geology; shark and billfish biology and conservation; fish physiology, genetics, and ecology; molecular biology; microbiology; biodiversity; and physical oceanography.

The center offers a Ph.D. in Oceanography/Marine Biology; M.S. degrees in Marine Biology, Coastal Zone Management (CZM), Marine Environmental Sciences, and Biological Sciences; and an M.A. in Marine and Coastal Studies (online). Traditional and condensed courses are held in the evenings at our 10-acre, ocean-front campus. The M.A. is completely online and many M.S. courses (and the full CZM program) are also available online. The M.S. and M.A. programs can be completed in as little as two years. Two graduate certificate programs are also available.

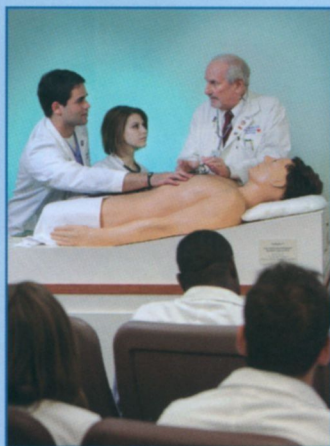
The OC houses three preeminent research institutes: the National Coral Reef Institute, the Guy Harvey Research Institute, and the Save Our Seas Shark Center, as well as the innovative Center of Excellence for Coral Reef Ecosystems Research.












Institute for the Study of Human Service, Health, and Justice

early childhood and autism studies

Mailman Segal Center for Human Development

The Mailman Segal Center for Human Development (MSC) is a multidisciplinary demonstration and professional training center for education, research, and the advancement of knowledge in early childhood, parenting, and autism across the life span. Located at the Jim & Jan Moran Family Center Village, the center offers educational programs, clinical services, and academic programs in collaboration with other NSU divisions. MSC is committed to community outreach and serves as a professional training site for practicums and postdoctoral and internship opportunities.

At the core of the center is the nationally accredited Family Center Infant/Toddler and Preschool Programs. Other programs include the Parenting Place; Starting Right, an early intervention program for children at risk for, or diagnosed with, autism; the Baudhuin Preschool (in partnership with Broward County Public Schools) serving children with autism spectrum disorders; and the Unicorn Children's Foundation Clinic, which provides assessments for children at risk for autism and offers a specialized program for children with severe behavioral challenges.



pre-k–grade 12



University School

At University School, our pre-k through grade 12 classrooms are led by some of the nation's most enthusiastic and knowledgeable instructors. Through individualized attention, they promote every student's ability to learn, grow, and succeed academically, socially, and personally. To broaden the educational horizon, emphasis is placed on encouraging and enhancing each child's creativity, talents, and interests in the classroom and beyond.

Our unique partnership with NSU offers our students engaging, interactive learning experiences. With help from the university's law center, our Middle School students have the opportunity to prepare for mock trial competitions. As part of their capstone projects, juniors and seniors can even conduct research with NSU professors. More than 90 percent of our graduates are eligible for Bright Futures Scholarships, and 100 percent are accepted to colleges and universities around the United States and throughout the world.

museum of art | fort lauderdale

As part of Nova Southeastern University, the Museum of Art | Fort Lauderdale is home to a permanent collection of more than 6,000 pieces. The museum offers events, lectures, and activities to complement exhibits and brings art education to South Florida communities with curriculum-based courses for experienced artists and beginners. At the museum's AutoNation Academy of Art and Design, students learn in a culture that supports individual development with courses that cover broad fundamentals, instill creative concepts, and foster a greater appreciation of the visual arts. Taught by working artists, students can choose to learn during five- or ten-week sessions, as well as one-day and multiday workshops. The museum offers courses for adults and students in grades 1 through 12 from a wide range of disciplines including drawing, painting, photography, ceramics, sculpture, printmaking, fiber arts, digital arts, and more.

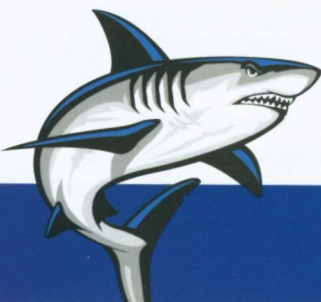


nsu athletics

The NSU Sharks athletic teams compete in the Sunshine State Conference as a part of the National Collegiate Athletic Association (NCAA) Division II. NSU offers a wide range of intercollegiate programs for men and women, including baseball, basketball, cheerleading, cross country, golf, rowing, soccer, softball, swimming and diving, tennis, track, and volleyball.

Come out and support the Sharks and catch the excitement of NSU's student-athletes, who are among the nation's best. Since joining the NCAA in 2002, NSU athletic teams have

- won five NCAA Division II National Championships—four in women's golf (2009, 2010, 2011, and 2012) and one in men's golf (2012)
- had five individual national champions with three in women's golf (Sandra Changkija, 2010; Taylor Collins, 2011; and Abbey Gittings, 2012), one in rowing (Varsity 4, 2009), and one in women's swimming (Erin Black, 2012)
- had their first Olympian (Esau Simpson) who competed in the 100 freestyle at the 2012 London Olympics
- won the prestigious NCAA Student-Athlete Sportsmanship Award (Courtney Berger, 2011)
- captured an NCAA record of six consecutive women's golf National Player of the Year Awards (Maria Garcia-Austt, 2007; Sandra Changkija, 2008, 2009, 2010, and 2011; and Abbey Gittings, 2012)
- captured their first men's golf National Player of the Year Award (Ben Taylor, 2012)
- produced 77 NCAA All-American student-athletes
- produced 52 NCAA Scholar All-American student-athletes
- captured 19 Sunshine State Conference Championships
- had 34 Sunshine State Conference Player and Freshman of the Year honorees
- produced 7 NCAA Division II National Players of the Year
- produced 5 NCAA Division II Freshmen Players of the Year
- won the prestigious 2008 SSC Women's Mayor's Cup All-Sports Trophy

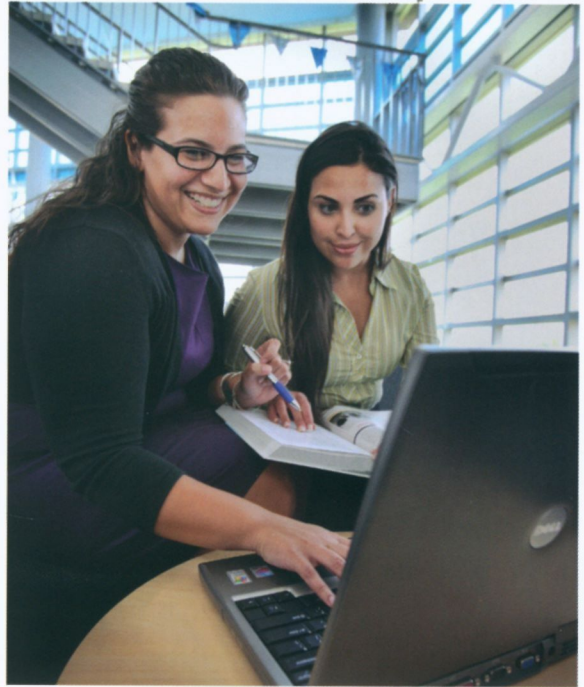

Financial Assistance

When it comes to financing your NSU education, you are not alone. Full-tuition scholarships are awarded to many high-achieving students. Additionally, the university offers need-based and merit-based support through state, federal, and institutional aid including grants, scholarships, student employment, and loans. You might be surprised to learn that, in many cases, the cost of attending this private university may be even less than attending a Florida public university, for both in-state and out-of-state students. Florida residents can apply their Florida Pre-Paid College funds and Bright Futures awards toward their NSU tuition. All incoming, full-time undergraduate day students will be considered for the Nova Dean's Award, based on their GPAs.

Grants, scholarships, and awards are available for qualifying students who

- are new to NSU as incoming or transfer students (undergraduate and graduate levels)
- demonstrate a career promise in a helping profession such as medicine, social service, performing and fine arts, business, law, or Jewish communal service/the rabbinate
- are majoring in education; physical, life, or computer science; engineering; mathematics; technology; or a critical foreign language



- are veterans eligible for the VA's Yellow Ribbon scholarship program
- serve as active-duty military officers
- work as salaried primary care physicians/physician assistants in an underserved area
- work as resident, graduate, or other types of on-campus assistants at NSU
- meet one or more of thousands of qualifications not listed here
