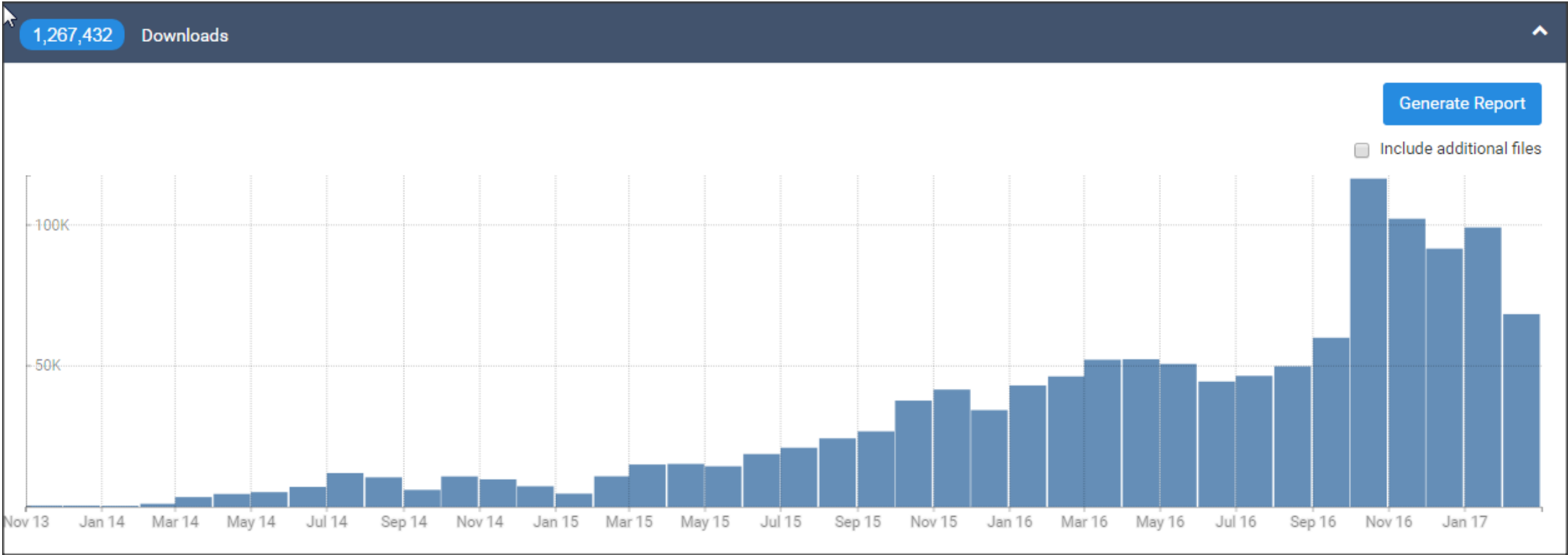

# Faculty Readership Map




