Item 1 Welcome and Announcements

Action: Dana greeted everyone.

Item 3 Reschedule CC meetings – Dana

Item 4 Lesson plan format for MS ICP students – Jan

Discussion: Jan would like to have a lesson plan template for the MS ICP students (one does

not currently exist in the internship handbook or syllabi). Julie shared a sample Marzano lesson plan and Dana shared a template that she had created for her interns. Mel suggested that rubrics be created for the lesson plan. Sidi suggested adding links to the various standards and models, rather than trying to make one

template that will work for every state and district.

Outcome: Faculty will send their lesson plan templates and suggestions to Dana, who will

compile and share them.

Item 5 Applied Professional Experience (699) courses: Assessments – Dana/Mary K.

Discussion: Mary K. had asked that we discuss the assessment requirements for the 699

courses. Dana had asked about potential changes to the capstone courses (Wilma & Dana have been discussing changes for the EC and ECSE 699 capstones). Sidi pointed out that the current assessments are tied to the NCATE [now CAEP]

standards and reports, so changes would be difficult.

Outcome: Faculty will send Dana any ideas/suggestions for modifying the 699 courses.
