3. Seminar. Enrollment limited to 20 students. Students may arrange with the professor to concurrently take one (1) or two (2) hours of Advanced Research in conjunction with this Seminar. This course will fulfill the writing requirement if you receive a grade of C+ or better.

4. Prerequisites: Evidence, Criminal Procedure, Trial Advocacy. Enrollment limited to 20 students. Note: No student may earn more than nine (9) semester credit hours toward graduation during his/her law school career in Clinical Legal Education.
5. Written permission of Clinical Director required for enrollment. Note: No student may earn more than nine (9) semester credit hours toward graduation during his/her law school career in Clinical Legal Education.
6. Prerequisite or Co-requisite: Evidence. Enrollment limited to 20 students.
7. Course approval form signed by professor who will supervise research and paper must be presented at time of registration.
8. Limited to 20 students. Paper required. This course will NOT fulfill the Writing Requirement.
