# Apply

---

- Make and submit a resume, cover letter, etc
  - Handshake
  - JobX
  - Newsletters
  - CAPS
- Prioritize internships that you are passionate about and will advance you in your career



# Show interest and professionalism

---

During the interview / preview phase

- Schedule an appointment with CAPS for interview and professionalism training + resume building
- Speak with your academic advisor if you would like academic credit for your internship



# Follow Up

---

Show that you are interested in the position

Send a cordial follow up email

- Thank them for their time
- Restate your interest
- Do research, then ask questions
