Program Description

The complete degree requirements are described in the <u>catalog</u>. Listed here is a summary. Students enrolled in the program are offered a choice of one of five specialization areas, depending on their career goals. The specialization areas are

Adult Education

Computing and Information Technology

Health Care Education

Higher Education

Vocational, Technical, and Occupational Technology

Students are required to complete six core and two specialization seminars. The specialization seminars will depend on the student's choice of specialization area and are taken in conjunction with the summer institute. The six core seminars are

Research Methodology

Curriculum and Program Planning

Governance and Management

Human Resources Development

Leadership

Societal Factors Affecting Education

In addition, four practicums are required. These help students apply theory to practice. Finally, students must pass a comprehensive examination and complete a Major Applied Research Project (MARP), which is a capstone project equivalent to a dissertation.
