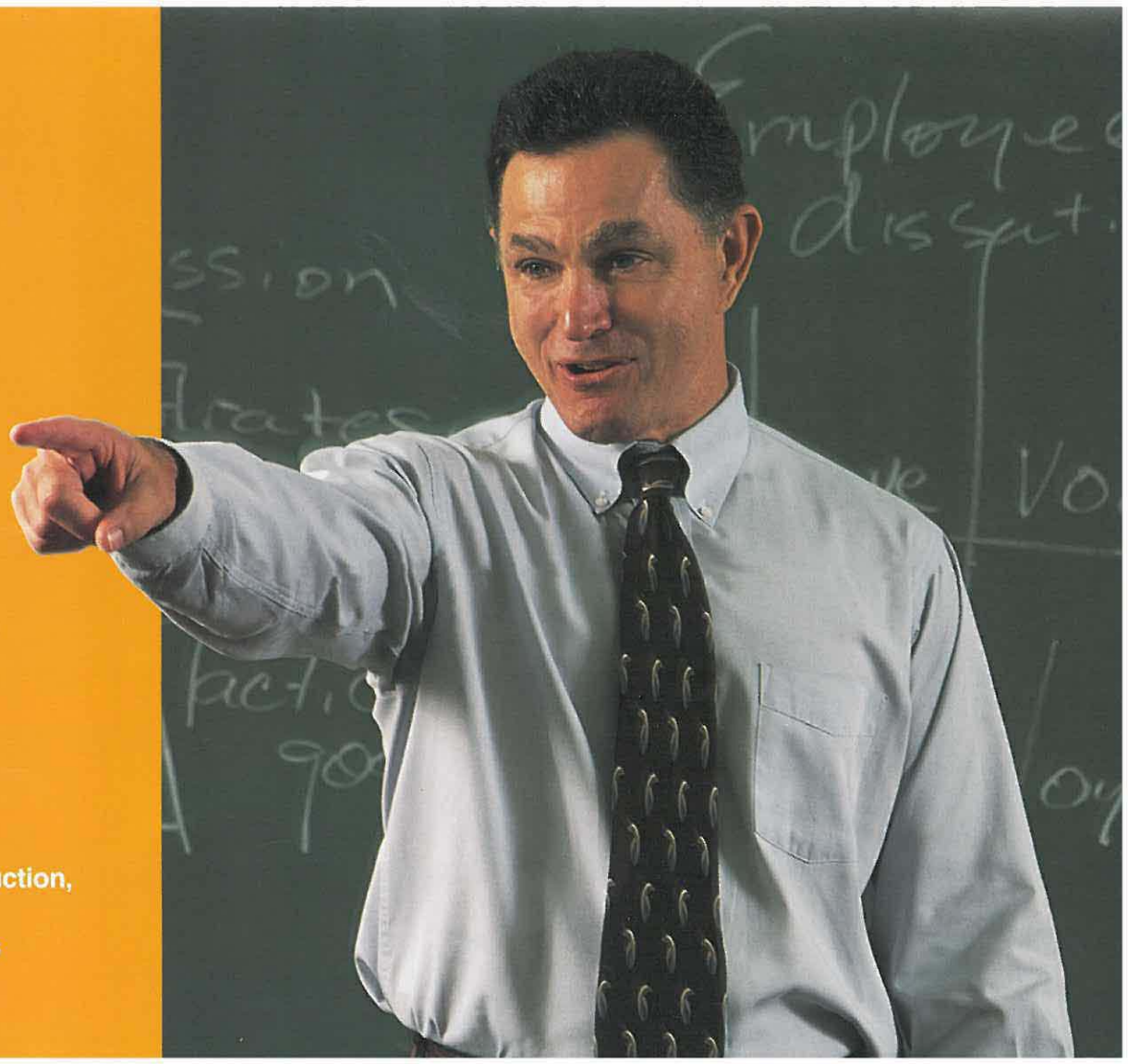

March 20–April 3, 2003—Students acquire NSU email accounts at www.fgse.nova.edu/gtep/miniterm/miniemail.html

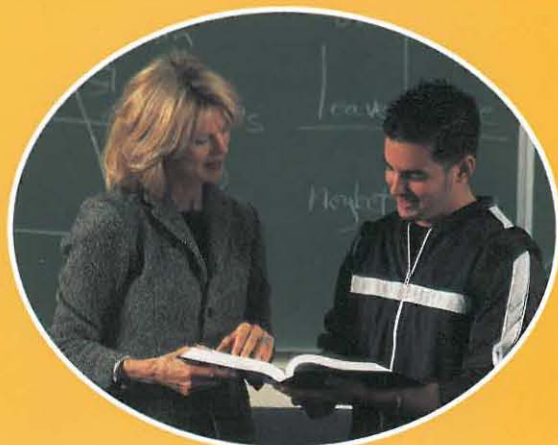
April 4, 2003—Students can access courses through WebCT at <http://webct.nova.edu/>.
