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


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

Nova Southeastern University's Graduate Teacher Education Program (GTEP) offers an array of majors in teacher education and school administration, providing opportunities for the working professional to earn master's and educational specialist degrees.

The curriculum is designed to enable teachers to add certification areas and endorsements, renew current certification areas, and increase their levels of expertise within their fields. Through its Initial Certification Plan, GTEP provides opportunities for persons with bachelor's degrees in other fields to enter teaching.

The focus in all programs is on growth in professional practice, application of current research and theory to the students' professional work, acquistion and enhancement of leadership capacities, and the achievement of career objectives.

The Graduate Teacher Education Program offers persons with bachelor's or graduate degrees four types of opportunities to meet their educational goals. All four options share a common instructional system and mission, but are designed to meet different needs.

### M.S. and Ed.S. Majors in Education

Designed for persons who already have a bachelor's or graduate degree in education and who wish to obtain a graduate degree, add certification areas, or increase their level of expertise in their current field.

### **Educational Leadership**

Designed for experienced, certified teachers who wish to obtain a graduate degree and/or gain their initial administrative credential.

### **Initial Certification Plan**

Designed for persons with bachelor's degrees in fields other than education who wish to gain a graduate degree and initial certification in teaching.


### **Endorsement and Certification Renewal Options**

Designed for persons who do not seek a degree but wish to take courses to add a certification area, renew their certification, or take individual courses for professional development.

# GETTING STARTED: PROVISIONAL ADMITTANCE

Students who want to get started on studies right away may do so through the Graduate Teacher Education Program's Provisional Admittance, which requires a student to:

- Have an earned baccalaureate or graduate degree from a regionally accredited college or university
- Submit a graduate admission application form and application fee
- Provide official transcripts from all colleges and/or universities attended
- If currently certified to teach, submit a copy of a valid professional or temporary teaching certificate

# TO CONTINUE: ADMISSION TO DEGREE CANDIDACY

- Earn a 3.0 grade point average (4.0 scale) in required courses
- Successfully complete a writing assessment (offered five times a year at all sites)


