**A**ccent Reduction is a program designed to increase effective communication using standard English pronunciation. It is an intensive program for non-native speakers of English. Participants receive instruction and practice in:

- vowel and consonant production
- voicing
- intonation
- stress patterns
- idioms of American English
- general communication skills

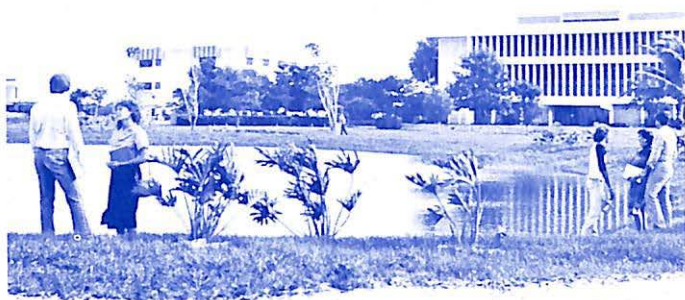
An initial assessment of each participant's speech pattern is obtained.

Classes are held regularly for six-week periods, meeting two hours per night on the

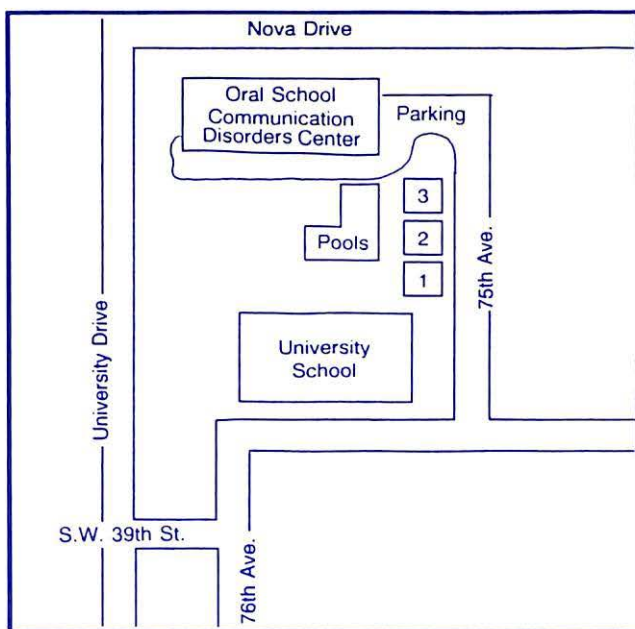

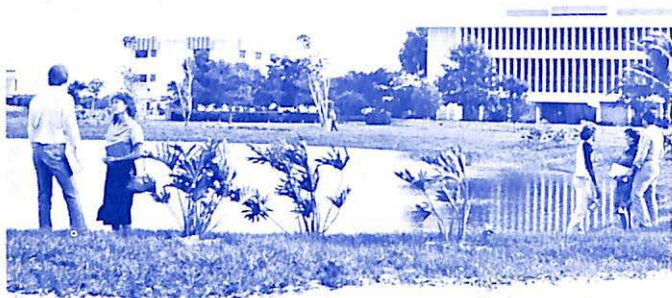

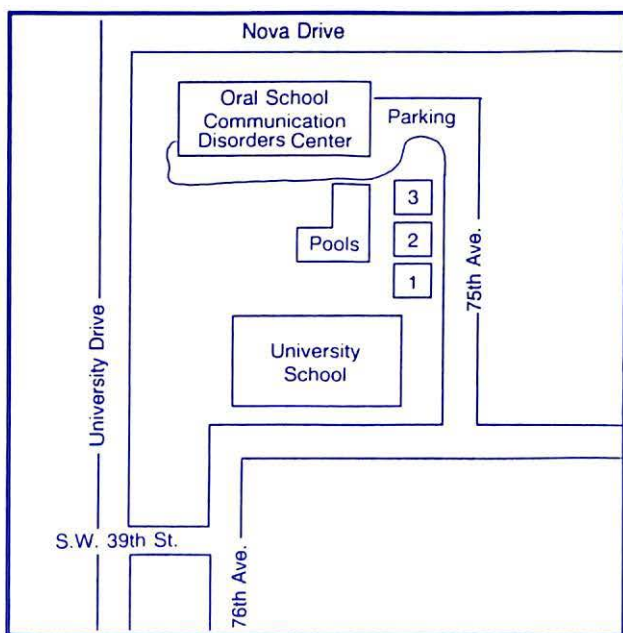
