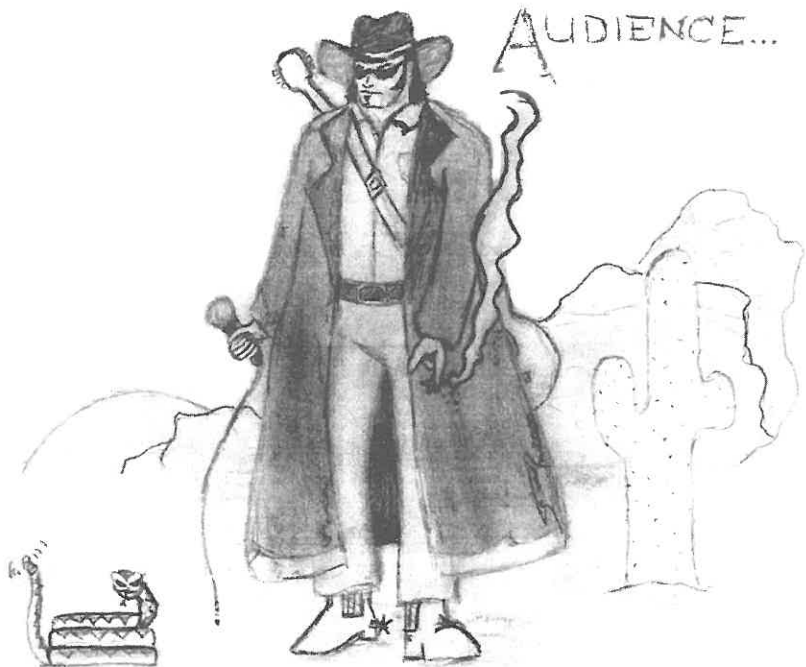
The chords sound good, but the words don't click
