SUBJ: Schedule Change for PSY 731, Therapy Intervention III:  
Behavior Therapy

This course will be offered on Wednesdays from 4:00 - 7:00 p.m. during the second (Spring) semester, 1985.

Prerequisite: Introductory course in Behavior Therapy or Behavior Modification, or consent of instructor.

This is an advanced course in behavior theory and therapy, emphasizing process variables in individual (and extended individual) client therapy in out-patient or consulting room settings.

Among topics included:

Bases for decisions regarding choice of behavioral procedures;

Analysis and practice (with case materials) in relevant therapeutic skills;

Delineation of those parts of behavior therapy that involve verbal variables or "talking" as they relate to behavior change.
